## Tracie Library Services\*

• **Study and In-Library Research\***: Visitors are invited to use the Tracie Music Library by appointment, for consultation, to conduct research, browse, request copies, etc. Because the Library is a research archive, not a lending library, materials may be used in the Library with Archivist assistance\*, and/or users may request copies of materials (please see "**Copies**," and "**NOTICE**" below, and **Footnote** at bottom of page 2).

- **For an Appointment**: contact Tracie Library Archivist Mary Mohler (see page 2).

• **Archivist Research, Archivist Assistance, Consultation\***, as possible (please see **Footnote** at bottom of page 2 regarding Library's current capacity for accepting requests).

Archivist search for information, materials or ranges of materials, archivist assistance or consultation, and other associated services, are available FREE for the first half hour, and \$30.00 per hour thereafter.

• **Copies\***: Copies of materials in the Tracie Library can be made for user, within copyright laws and use restrictions placed on materials. Generally, most works allow copying of excerpts for users, **providing copies are for personal study and non-commercial use only** (see "**NOTICE**" below).

### Photocopy from Printed Works (see "**NOTICE**" below)

BLACK/WHITE: letter or legal size: flat = 25¢/page; book = 30¢/page; plus shipping and handling (S/H);

COLOR: letter size: flat = \$1.50/page; book = \$1.55/page; plus shipping and handling (S/H).

COLOR: legal size: flat = \$2.00/page; book = \$2.05/page; plus shipping and handling (S/H).

*Example: 20 pages B/W letter size flat, @ \$5.00 copying, plus \$5.00 S/H (up to 13 oz.), total \$10.00.*

### Copy from Audio Works onto Audiocassette (see "**NOTICE**" below)

\$10.00 per audiocassette direct-copy from source without stop-start changes; for stop-start changes from source(s), add \$1.00 per stop-start change to the cost of copying to audiocassette, plus S/H.

*Example: one audiocassette direct-copy @ \$10.00 copying, plus \$5.00 S/H (up to 13 oz.), total \$15.00.*

*Example: one audiocassette with five(5) stop-start changes: copy from source @ \$10.00, plus \$5.00 for five stop-start changes @ \$1.00 each, plus \$5.00 S/H (up to 13 oz.), total \$20.00.*

(Sorry, the Tracie Library can copy audio works from CD but does not currently copy to CD.)

Further reproduction of any copy from the Tracie Library, in any form, could be an infringement of United States or other copyright law, or a violation of donor-placed use-restrictions on Library material.

### Copy from Video Works onto VHS Cassette or DVD (see "NOTICE" on page 1)

The Tracie Library arranges for videos to be copied by an outside professional agency; estimated costs run roughly \$20.00-\$30.00 for the first two-hour high-speed (higher quality) VHS, or for copy to DVD, copied directly from source without stop-start changes (stop-start changes add \$6.00 per stop-start to the cost of copying); plus shipping and handling. Copies may be made at six-hour extended long-play speed VHS (lower quality) if user wishes.

*Example: one VHS direct-copy @ \$25.00 copying cost, plus \$5.00 S/H (up to 13 oz.), total \$30.00*

*Example: one VHS with five (5) stop-start changes from source @ \$25.00 copying, plus \$30.00 for five stop-starts @ \$6.00 each, plus \$5.00 S/H (up to 13 oz.), total \$60.00*

Fees for services may be prepaid or paid on user's receipt of completed request; method of payment will be agreed upon by user and Archivist at time of request. Payments may be made in cash, check or money order made out to **Nordic Heritage Museum**.

## Delivery of Requested Items from Tracie Library

When service is completed, requested item(s) can be picked up by user, delivered to user in person, or delivered to user by mail or email, as arranged at time of request. Allow two weeks after Library receipt of request for shipping of requested items, unless otherwise arranged.
